No. LAW/LEGN-12/2026.—The following Act of the Arunachal Pradesh Legislative Assembly which was passed in the Sixth Session of the Eighth Legislative Assembly and received the assent of the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is hereby published for general information.

THE ARUNACHAL PRADESH APPROPRIATION (NO. 2) ACT, 2026 (Act No. 5 of 2026)

An

Act

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the consolidated fund of the State of Arunachal Pradesh for the services of a part of the financial year, 2026-2027.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Arunachal Pradesh in the Seventy-Seventh Year of the Republic of India as follows :-

- (1) This Act may be called the Arunachal Pradesh Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 2026. Short title.
(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from 1st April, 2026 and same shall be in force for the whole financial year, 2026-2027 ending 31st March, 2027.
- From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Arunachal Pradesh there may be withdrawn sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of **Rupees Thirty Six Thousand Six Hundred Six Crore Sixty Nine Lakh** only towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year, 2026-27 in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule. Withdrawal of ₹ **36606,69,00,000** from and out of the consolidated fund for the financial year, 2026-2027.
- The sums authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Arunachal Pradesh by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year. Appropriation.
